KAMALAME CAY PRIVATE RESORT & RESIDENCES, BAHAMAS

Kamalame Cay is a 96-acre private island resort situated adjacent to the island of Andros. Getting to this sliver of paradise is half the fun—fly into Nassau and board a seaplane to arrive on Kamalame's beach, where staff is waiting to settle you into your oceanfront cottage.

There are no cars on the island and all the rooms and suites (19 total) come with a golf cart to explore the resort's winding paths, tropical foliage and white sand beaches. The casual chic vibe of Kamalame Cay is best described as "barefoot luxury." Owners David Hew and Michael King have made the relaxed style of Kamalame Cay their passion project. All the cottages are individually decorated, featuring soothing pastel palettes, soaker tubs, blowing curtains and unbelievable ocean views. Enjoy the sunrise from your bed or take in the sea breeze through the coconut trees

by watching the day unfold from your balcony, beach lounge or hammock. A breakfast basket with fresh coffee, baked goods and just-squeezed orange juice is delivered daily to your door.

At Kamalame you can literally do everything or nothing at all—activities include kayaking, snorkelling, fishing, cycling and tennis. A couple's massage in the Overwater Spa is a must, where you can relax and watch tropical fish swim by through the glass floor. Cocktails at the Tiki Bar are a daily imperative and the on-island dining is simply superb. Seasonal, eco-friendly meals of contemporary Caribbean cuisine are served every day at the Great House. This romantic and deserted island is literally a honeymoon fantasy come true—you will be planning your anniversary visit before you've left for the mainland.
